Re: SCHOLARSHIPS FOR CANADIAN POSTGRADUATES STUDYING IN THE UK

This year the Canadian Centennial Scholarship Fund (CCSF) award competition **opens Wednesday 16th January, 2019** for submissions from all Canadian graduate students studying full-time, multi-year graduate programmes in the United Kingdom.

As you will note from the enclosed information sheet, we grant awards annually, ranging from £2,000.00 to £5,000.00. Last year we granted a total of £75,000 to 17 students, including eleven £5,000 scholarships. These awards are for the academic year commencing September 2019. We would appreciate it very much if you would bring this notice to the attention of any Canadian students registered at your institution who may be eligible to apply. The deadline for applications is **12 midnight Sunday March 10th, 2019**.

The Trustees of the Canadian Centennial Scholarship Fund (CCSF) are pleased to announce the availability of funds for awards (£2000-£5000) to Canadian men and women for the academic year commencing in **September 2019**. These awards are for academic and artistic studies in the UK, and are exclusively for students who have already commenced their multi-year studies in the UK. The CCSF is proud to have awarded, since 1967, over £800,000 to approximately 500 talented Canadians studying across multiple disciplines including science, engineering, social science, humanities, music, creative art, design and more. Up to 17 awards may be given, and include **The Mary LeMessurier** award for the study of History and the **Belle Shenkman** award for the Study of Arts. A total of £75,000 was given to 17 students in 2018.

INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS

Full details regarding eligibility, required documentation, schedule and deadline, how to apply and rules for submission can be found in the Information for Students and on our website www.canadianscholarshipfund.co.uk. In summary:

DEADLINE

The competition will open 16th January 2019. Applications and all relevant material (including references and transcripts) must be received **no later than 12 midnight Sunday March 10th, 2019**. There are no extensions.

ELIGIBILITY (Previous applicants may re-apply)

To qualify for a CCSF award, an applicant must:

1. Be a Canadian citizen.
2. Be currently enrolled full-time in a multi-year postgraduate programme, and at the time of application attending a UK university or similar institution **and completed at least one full time term of study**.
3. Be able to demonstrate academic excellence.
4. Require funds to complete their studies.
